Advisory for Indian Nationals in the Netherlands

As you are aware, a number of measures have been taken by the Government of India (GoI) to contain the spread of COVID-19. GoI has advised the Indian nationals to avoid any non-essential travel. Flights to India are suspended from 22 March 2020. As per the recent communication of the Directorate General of Civil Aviation of India, scheduled international flights into India remain suspended up to 14 April 2020.

We understand that many Indian nationals who include students, professionals, businesspersons, tourists, short stay visa holders and others in the Netherlands are unable to return to India due to COVID-19 related travel restrictions. Authorities in India are aware of the situation. We request your patience and understanding.

The Embassy of India, The Hague will update the Indian nationals if there are any changes in the travel advisory or if any option to travel to India becomes available. We request Indian nationals in the Netherlands to stay connected with us through our social media platforms and check for updates.
